Invasion Games Students will participate in opposed and unopposed practises – thinking technically and tactically as to how they will be successful. They will plan and evaluate performances, giving feedback to classmates while managing success and failure. They will develop different social and emotional skills as well as the physical skills needed in the games and sports participated in.	Outdoor Adventurous Activities (OAA) highlights the need for children to explore the outdoors and develop physical skills they may be unable to indoors. Children are required to rely on mental and physical skills and learn essential skills for their personal and social development.	Invasion Games Pupils will develop the physical, social, emotional, and psychological skills needed to participate and enjoy physical sport. In this unit, the focus will be on developing teamwork skills and considering how to successfully work with others.	Net and Wall Students will continue to work on their hand- eye coordination skills while working independently and as part of a team. There will be an emphasis on evaluating performance and being a part of opposed practises. They will explore new tactical problems while focusing on different leadership styles.	Striking and Fielding Pupils are given opportunities to work in collaboration with others, play fairly demonstrating an understanding of the rules, as well as being respectful of the people playing with and against. Pupils will learn how to strike a ball into space as well as thinking about fielding principles.	Athletics In this unit, pupils will look at the fine details that impact running, jumping, and throwing techniques. They will be set challenges for time and distance using different styles and combinations. Pupils will consider how to achieve their greatest speed, distance, or accuracy and how to beat their personal best, evaluating themselves and others.

Literacy

Our football-themed literacy activities help to build confidence, develop pupils' language capabilities, and contextualise their learning. By engaging pupils through activities which include writing inspiring half-time team talks, match reports, or a poem about their favourite player, our sessions support pupils to practice their writing composition, speaking and listening, and creative language.

Numeracy

Our football-themed numeracy challenges bring maths into a real life context. For example: using football statistics, fantasy football budgets and the inner financial operations of a football stadium to explore the application of key numeracy skills. During our sessions pupils can practice their adding, subtracting, multiplying and dividing as well as doing mental calculations and solving problems using time, measurements or money.



PSHE

Our workshops cover **key life skills topics** that focus on exploring and developing personal wellbeing, aspirations for the future, equality and diversity, and personal lifestyle choices. **Sessions are connected to the real world using the context of sport** to enthuse pupils when tackling challenging topics such as resilience, self-esteem, and fair play.

STEM

Our Soccer STEM sessions use **football and robotics** to teach core science, technology, engineering, and maths skills. Using our **unique Brighton & Hove Albion Sphero robots** we show pupils **how to code, think about movement, angles, problem-solving, teamwork and communication**. These sessions support the development of financial literacy, critical analysis, digital literacy, and creativity.

What we offer PE Teacher CPD



We want to support schools to deliver excellence in their PE and sports activities. Our qualified and experienced staff can support the continuous professional development (CPD) of your teachers in their delivery of PE and multi-sports lessons in order to build teacher confidence.
